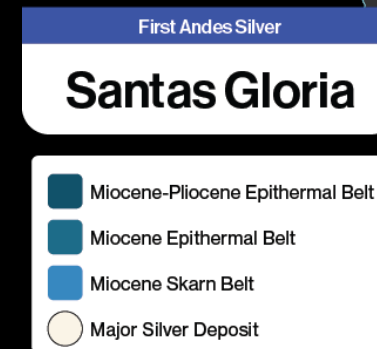

Drill Ready Santas Glorias Project Peru

- 100% ownership of a very high grade silver base metal -gold intermediate sulphidation system in a major Peruvian mining district 100 km from Lima with excellent road access.
- Fully permitted for drilling with drill pads already constructed. Drill contract signed. Community access agreement valid until 2028. Archeological certificates water permits and authorization for drilling(AIA) obtained.



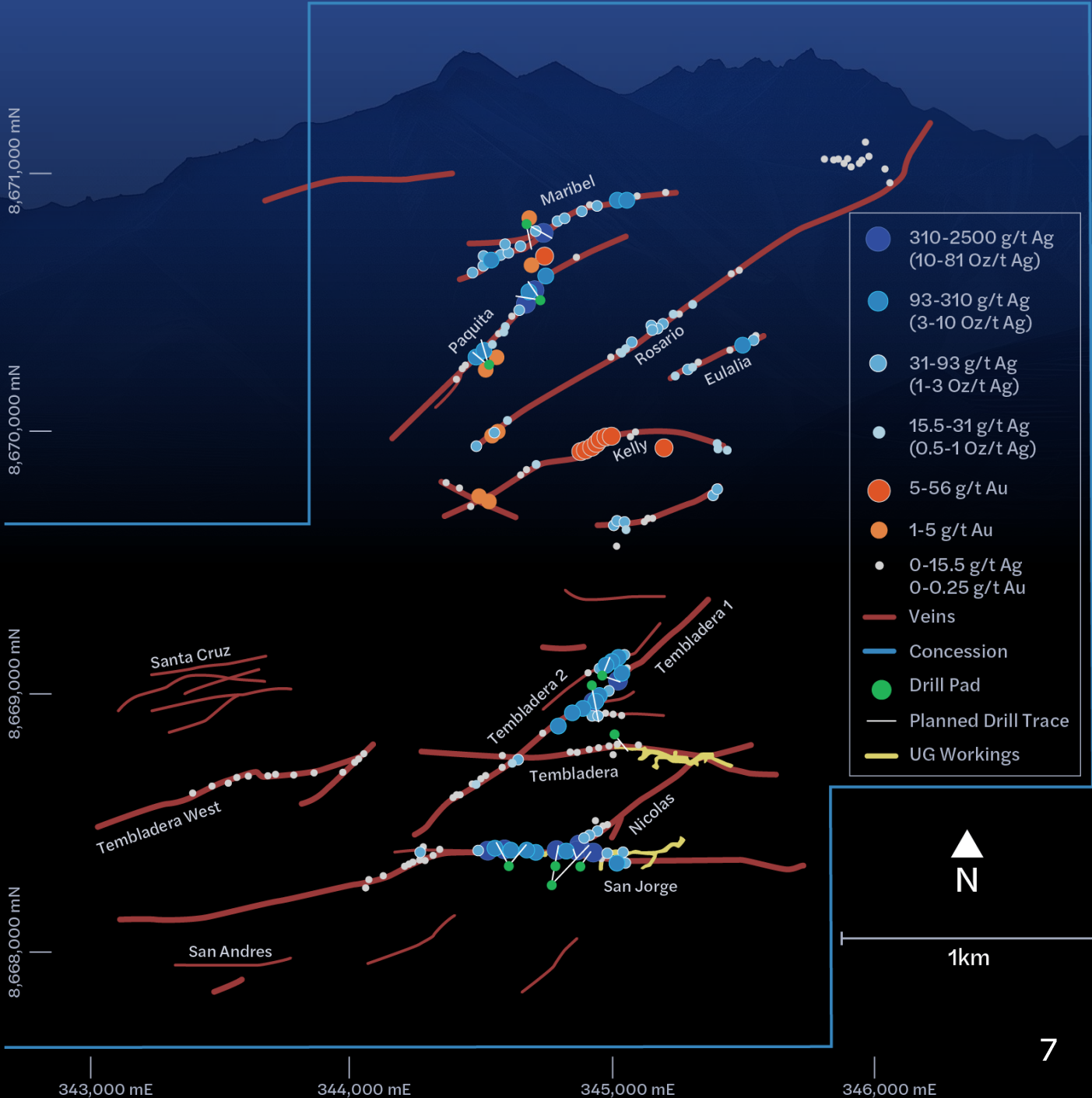
Potential Milling Opportunity

There are a number of mines operating in the Morococha camp with excess mill capacity for high grade silver-base metal feed that are within 40 to 50 km of Santas Gloria. At least one private Peruvian miner also has capacity to provide underground miners and equipment, drastically reducing timeline and CAPEX requirements to cash flow.



Drill Ready Santas Glorias Project Peru

- Over 12 kilometers of high grade silver and gold veins present multiple high value near surface drill targets. Never previously drill tested.
- Limited historical underground mining confirms high grade mineralization with underground channel samples returning silver grades in excess of 10,000 g/t.
- Up to 2500 g/t Ag and 56 g/t Au in surface channel samples.
